Cheaper **buffet lunch**, there are two to three different choices or prepared salad that costs 8 euro for guests.  
More expensive buffet lunch costs 9.50 euro for guests.

The lunches include one glass of milk, juice or similar and one glass of water, basic salad buffet, bread, and dessert. The dessert is coffee, tea, fruit or a small dessert served in a minibowl.

**Do not mix dishes**, because they might charge extra for that.

There are two canteens, the bigger one is aimed for students and the smaller one for personnel. I recommend the bigger one because we are many and the rest of the personnel of the Chemistry Department does not want to queue too long.

The nearest **restrooms** are on the other side of the aula. Restrooms can also be found outside the canteens.

The **poster boards** are in the aula outside the lecture hall, choose your favourite poster board and put up your poster there.

If you want a **certificate** stating that you have participated in the winter school, please take one and add your name. I sign it. The unfilled forms can be found at the exit of the lecture hall.

Note that there are two versions, one is for participation and one is for participation and showing a poster.

Students who want 3 ECTS for the winter school have to write an **essay**. We make a list of essays titles available. Lecturers can help by suggesting essay titles. We read and approve the essays.
